

Pegasus Therapeutic Equestrian Center Dressage Schooling Show and Ride a Test Clinic

Covid-19 Guidelines We would like to thank everyone in advance for their patience and understanding of this difficult situation we are in. Pegasus has worked hard to keep everyone safe and healthy. We hope that you will enjoy the schooling show and the opportunity to get your horses out!

Before arrival at Pegasus Farm please self-assess for any Covid-19 symptoms. Fever, coughing, body aches etc.. We ask that you do not attend if you display any of the previous symptoms.

We ask that you bring only one other person with you aside from your trainer.

Trailing

1. Trailing entrance is off of State Rte. 44
2. Please park your horse trailer 25ft from other trailers
3. Please park cars in the area prior to the gate. Trailers will only be allowed through the gate.
4. Please be mindful of the social distancing guidelines of 6ft. in the trailer area. When this cannot be maintained a facial covering is highly recommended.
5. There is a water pump that can be used at the northwest corner of the pasture. Please use the hand sanitizer provided before touching it.

Check in and Test Pickup

1. Rider packets can be picked up in the viewing room in the main barn. You do not have to return your number. We highly recommend face coverings when inside the building. There will be cones set as line markers to maintain social distancing.
2. There is hand sanitizer available at the entry please use upon entering the building
3. Tests and ribbons will be placed for pick up at a designated table only one person at a time at the table. Again follow social distancing Guidelines when waiting.

Stabling

1. There will be limited stalls available and will be spread out.
2. Groom and tack up in the stalls only

Warm up arenas

1. Pegasus asks that you maintain proper distancing when on your horse also.
2. There will be a limited amount of horses allowed in the warm up at one time please be courteous to other competitors.
3. Lunging will be allowed in the trailer area or round pen.
4. Use of the indoor for warm-up will be determined day of the show.

Show times

1. Times will be scheduled to allow for traffic flow and to maintain a safe and healthy competition show grounds.

Restrooms

1. The restrooms in the viewing room of the main barn will be available
2. There will be a port-a-potty available outside of the main barn.

Concessions

1. Concessions will be available with limited items

Spectators

1. Spectators are to maintain the social distance of 6 ft while on the show grounds. When that is not possible a face covering is highly recommended.

Precautions taken at Pegasus Therapeutic Equestrian Center

1. Ride times will spaced out and grouped to allow for CDC and USDF social distancing guidelines and Best Practices.
2. Runners will use folders when picking up tests.
3. All volunteers and staff will wear face coverings when there is more than one person in the viewing room.
4. When outside volunteers and staff will wear a facial covering when social distancing cannot be adhered to.
5. Test and ribbon pick up table will be wiped and cleaned between each class
6. Hand sanitizer will be provided at the front door of the main building to be used when entering the building.
7. There will be a separate entrance and exit to the main building.
8. The Judge and the Scribe will be set 6ft apart and wear facial coverings and have hand sanitizer available for handling the tests between riders.
